How We Use Your Personal Data (Legal Basis for Processing)

Where you have consented to us providing you with promotional offers and marketing, you are free to withdraw this consent at any time. *The purposes and reasons for processing your personal data are detailed below:* -

How Long We Keep Your Data

KBH only ever retains personal information for as long as is necessary and we have strict review and retention policies in place to meet these obligations. We are required under UK tax law to keep your basic personal data (name, address, contact details) for a minimum of 6 years after which time it will be destroyed.

Where you have consented to us using your details for direct marketing, we will keep such data until you notify us otherwise and/or withdraw your consent.

Lodging A Complaint
